ENDORSEMENT:

In my endorsement dated May 3, 2022, I scheduled this date for a sentencing hearing in relation to the Receiver's motion for a contempt order. Mr. McSevney attended the last hearing.

Mr. McSevney attended today with counsel, Mr. Marler. Mr. Marler assured me that Mr. McSevney intends to fully comply with the Receivership Order, and he requested an adjournment to allow him to assist Mr. McSevney to do so. Mr. Azeff submitted that it was appropriate to proceed with the sentencing hearing given the circumstances, including that there has not been compliance with the Receivership Order since the last hearing.

In the circumstances, I granted the requested adjournment in order to allow Mr. McSevney to comply with his obligations.

Mr. Marler will assist Mr. McSevney to comply with all of his obligations under the Receivership Order, including, specifically, paragraph 8 thereof (which was to be complied with within three dates of November 8, 2021 (the date of the Receivership Order). This is to be done forthwith.

The sentencing hearing is adjourned to July 19, 2022 at noon for one hour. The hearing will be in person at 330 University Avenue.
